



We manage asbestos sites.

Breathing in air containing asbestos fibres can lead to asbestos-related diseases. As a manager of any properties and facilities, you have a legal duty to manage the risk from asbestos and a duty to cooperate with relevant authorities and other parties with responsibilities for asbestos management. Although it is now illegal to use asbestos in the construction or refurbishment of any premises, it has been used extensively in the past and property managers must deal with this legacy.

The Asbestos module of the EnviroLIS system is used to track information related to any asset that contains asbestos or has the potential to have asbestos containing materials. Through a web-based system, this information can be distributed quickly and effectively to the individuals who need to know this information.

In the Asbestos module, data forms are used to manage buildings that have or may contain asbestos. The type of information that can be managed includes:

- Building addresses and contact names
- Ownership / leasing relationships
- Asbestos risk/type
- Where the Asbestos occurs
- Metadata about your Asbestos Audits
- Geographic coordinates of the buildings

The module also manages all of your asbestos-related photos and documents, providing you with all the information you need, clearly organised and in one place, and key dates can be attached to the Calendar and E-mail reminder module to help with the management of business processes

Buildings can be grouped under a Site name for easy querying and retrieval of information, both in the form of a hierarchical tree and on a map view for distribution analysis and personnel management, and advanced reporting capabilities allow for the interrogation of all your data.
