The Botswana LIS consists of seven distinct land management packages: Deeds Registry (land ownership); Plot and Plan Registry (registration of surveyed Land); Land Applications (allocation of lands, tracking board meetings and resolutions); Land Transactions (acquisition of lands, divestments, etc.); Mapping (display data sets on top of the country's cadastre); Physical Planning (management of development plans); and Asset Leases (management of leases, contracts, etc. related to government assets and tracking of payments).
